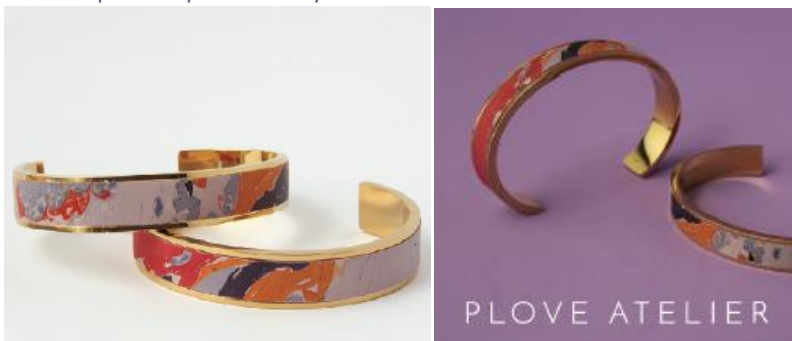

MIRROR is an artist duo consisting of Isabella Teng Yen Lin and Pierre Pourville. They draw on dream material, relying on free association and intuition to create their colourful, collaborative paintings, which the duo call Soul Art.

Singaporean artist **Teng Yen Lin** (b. 1990) grew up under the influence of an artistic family. She graduated in 2014 from the National University of Singapore with a B.A. (Hons) in English Literature, having spent a year (2011-2012) at Yale University on a full overseas scholarship.

As an exhibiting artist for the past nine years, Yen Lin has participated in creative collaborations with institutions such as Esplanade, OCBC Bank, and the Singapore Art Museum, among others. Her work has received prominent attention from both the English and Mandarin press, Mediacorp TV, and local radio.



Born in France in 1958, **Pierre Pourville** has spent years travelling around the globe, living in Europe, the Americas, and finally Asia. His experiences as a professional photo model and long-distance cyclist in his youth; cancer survivor, volunteer in a Panamanian orphanage; restaurant manager of the wildly successful La Escudilla in Guatemala in the 90's, show their influence in an artistic style that is creative, unconventional, and sensitively tuned to the twists and turns of the human experience.

His visual style leans towards the surrealistic, favouring a play of emotive forms and colours over traditional realism.

Lunch Talk by John Hou – Pearl Appreciation

John Hou is a Diploma Graduate in Pearls from the Gemological Institute of America. After retiring from his landscape consultancy business, John regularly conducts workshops to educate consumers on the knowledge of pearls.

2. Types of pearls
3. Seven values of pearls
4. Genuine and fake pearls

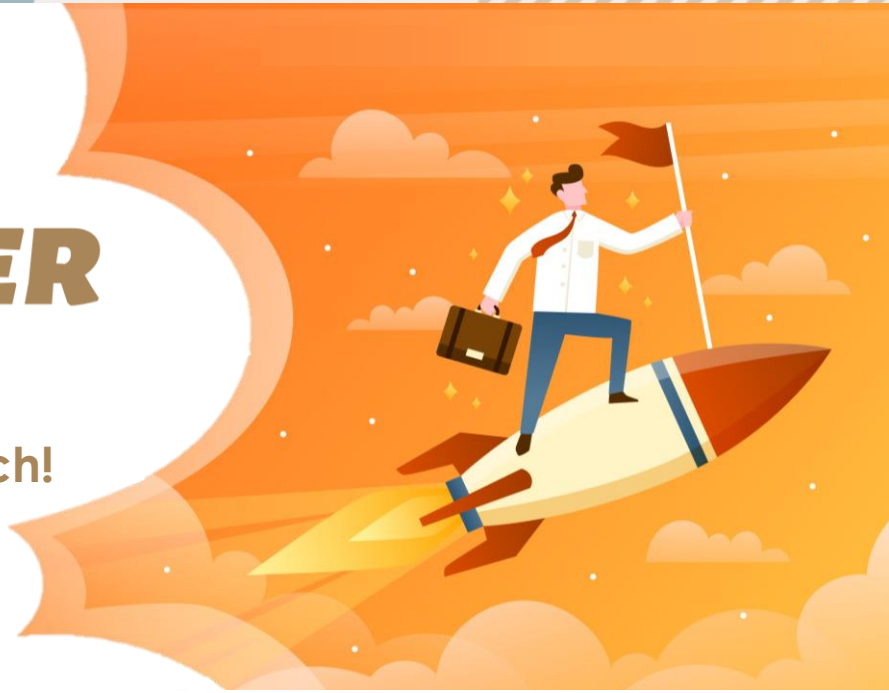
