PAYMENT OF MANAGEMENT FEES BY WAY OF ISSUE OF UNITS IN ASCOTT RESIDENCE TRUST

Ascott Residence Trust Management Limited (the “**Company**”), as manager of Ascott Residence Trust (“**Ascott Reit**”), wishes to announce that a total of 2,631,595 units in Ascott Reit (“**Units**”) have been issued at an issue price of S\$0.990 per Unit to the Company today as payment of the base fee and base performance fee (collectively, the “**Management Fees**”) for the period from 1 October 2011 to 31 December 2011 (both dates inclusive).
